2020-2021 TK-8th Fee Schedule

Registration Fee: \$125.00 per student

Registration fees are due at the time of enrollment and are non-refundable. This annual fee covers the period of August 2020 through July 2021. This fee covers dues for St. John's Parent-Teacher League, LCMS Pacific-Southwest District School Association fees, and includes a St. John's School Yearbook and a St. John's School Spirit T-Shirt. Shirts will be received in August 2020; Yearbooks will be delivered May 2021.

Materials Fees: TK: \$100 K: \$200 1st-5th: \$315 6th - 8th: \$330

This annual fee is used to purchase instructional materials, fund St. John's Technology Integration programs, and purchase necessary curricular materials. Materials fees can be paid in full or be split into two installments: ½ on or before July 1st, 2020 and ½ on or before July 20th, 2020.

St. John's 2020-2021 3rd grade students registration fee will include the purchase of a Chromebook. The cost of this device will be deducted from student materials fees one time only.

- ACH payments made by electronic funds transfer made via your QuickBooks invoice or through Vanco Financial Services.
- Enrollment paperwork for the Vanco program must be filled out at the time of registration each school year.

St. John's accepts Visa/MasterCard, Discover Card or American Express as payment for credit or debit tuition payments.

St. John's School is accredited by WASC (Western Association of Schools and Colleges & NLSA (National Lutheran Schools Association)

- All multiple student discounts are given to students in the same immediate family, living in the same household, and are only applied to students actively enrolled at St. John's School within the current school year.
- A 5% discount will be given if the family maintains active membership at St. John's Lutheran Church. Active church membership is defined as attendance at St. John's Lutheran Church at least twice a month, and completion of an adult faith development class offered by St. John's pastoral staff.
- A 5% discount is given for full payment of annual tuition. Payment must be made prior to July 31st, 2020.
- Students turning 5 years old on or before October 1, 2020 are eligible for kindergarten at St. John's School. Students turning 5 years old October 2nd, 2020 -June 1st, 2021 are eligible for TK at St. John's School.

Tuition Information

- Monthly tuition payments are due on the first of each month and are considered late after the fifteenth of that month.
- Tuition invoices will be emailed to the address on file in Gradelink. Payment can be made directly from this invoice using ACH, credit or debit card.
- School Age Care hours are tabulated at the end of each month. You will be billed for the amount of care used. School Age Care invoices will be emailed to the address on file by the 10th of the month and payment is due by the 20th of the month. A 10% fee will be assessed on late payments.
- Automatic payment of your monthly tuition is available through Vanco Financial Services. Payments can be withdrawn from your checking/savings account or charged directly to a credit or debit card. Auto pay authorizations are valid for (1) school year. A new authorization form must be filled out annually.
- Monthly tuition payments can be made on St. John's website: www.stjohnshemet.org
- Tuition balances must be kept current. If tuition payments are not made by the end of the month and no reasonable arrangement for payment is established, a 10% fee will be assessed and enrollment may be jeopardized.
- A referral from one of St. John's families is one of the highest compliments we can receive. In appreciation for these referrals, we offer the St. John's School Parent Referral Program. When a "New Family" enrolls at St. John's School and provides the Registrar with a form naming you as a "Referring Family", your family receives a \$300 referral credit for the upcoming academic year. More details about this program are available in the office.
- St. John's School "Scrip Toward Tuition" Plan allows families to decrease their monthly tuition through the planned purchase of Scrip cards or certificates. Scrip is a term that means, "substitute money". When you purchase Scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. Scrip can be used to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing, and other essentials. The difference between the face value of the card or certificate and the amount we pay is called a rebate, and this amount can be applied to your tuition account. All rebates accumulated by participating families will be utilized for tuition and fees associated with attendance at St. John's School. No cash for rebate exchange.
- St. John's offers school scholarships through the generosity of St. John's Ministries' congregation and their donations to the TJ & Eleanor Barber Legacy Scholarship Fund. Scholarship applications are available in the school office. Any scholarship awarded is based upon need and availability of funds. Families accepting scholarship are responsible for payment of the remaining tuition balance. All applications will be reviewed and notifications of tuition assistance will be sent by May 22nd, 2020. We make every effort to accommodate each family's financial needs. However, we do not have the resources to meet the needs of every eligible family who applies for assistance.
